Databases:

- Google scholar (1940/500),
- ERIC (13/10),
- EBSCOhost (Academic Search Premier, CINALH) (68/24)
- Finna (145), directly universities (Tampere, Jyväskylä, Lappi, Itä-Suomi, Turku, Helsinki): 75 dissertations, licentiate work 14
- Ammattikasvatuksen aikakauskirja
- Search words: "ammattikasvatus", vocational education and training (subject term), Finland (all)
- **Criteria:** peer reviewed, 2005-2017 (CINALH: abstract available)
- No: adult education, working life studies, higher education, transitions studies, editorials, conference proceedings
- **Four phases:** 1) identified the title 2) removed those that did not fit the criteria and duplicates, if abstract available read it 3) identified themes and 4) refined themes



Results: Four groups

- Ammattikasvatuksen aikakauskirja (Journal of Professional and VET): 42 articles (2 in English)
- Licentiate thesis: 14
- Dissertations: 75 (14 in English, 2 in Swedish)
- International journals: 34 articles
- -> 165 publications (ca. 78% in Finnish)

Themes

Pedagogy: 10

- 19 different themes, 11 individual topics
- 8 Most popular themes were:

Competence, expertise: 22 **Technology: 19 VET Teacher education: 15** Personal/professional growth: 12 Work-based learning: 11 Multi/interculturality: 11 **Entrepreneurship: 11**

- Big variety of topics
- Almost 80 % of all VET related research is published in Finnish
- Most popular topics in thesis work: competence and expertise
- Most popular topics in journals both national and international: technology related issues in learning
- Almost 2/3 of the dissertations were in the context of universities of applied sciences
